

- 4. COLOR your lollipop!












Oliver sees lots of amazing animals at the zoo! Draw your favorite animal in the box below.








Color the pieces. Cut them out, arrange, and glue them

Draw dots for eyes, and add a crown.






The carousel at Oliver's zoo has insects to ride!

You can draw insects, unicorns, sea creatures What would you like to ride?









Print two, cut out the pictures, lay them face down, and search for matches!





- 1. Each player gets a bingo card and a sheet of pictures/lollipops.
- 2. Cut out the pictures and glue them onto your card in any order. (You will have a few pictures left over.) Then, cut out the lollipops.
- 3. Cut out ANOTHER full set of pictures, and put those in a bowl.
- 4. Without looking, take turns reaching in to pick a picture from the bowl.

 When a picture is chosen, check your card to see if you have a match. If you do, place a lollipop on top!
- 5. The first player to have a row of 4 lollipops wins! (Rows can be vertical, horizontal, or diagonal.)
